BIOGRAPHIES CAST



VITOR BASSI PERFORMER

Vitor is a passionate multidisciplinary artist from Brazil with 24 years of experience in the arts, creating and performing in dance, theatre, musical theatre, film and television. In Brazil, he worked with important

companies and names of the artistic landscape. He has been doing the same in Ireland with well-known companies such as Irish Modern Dance Theatre, Femme Bizarre, Spraoi Studios, Smashing Times, Fidget Feet, Pan Pan Theatre and Company Philip Connaughton. Work with CoisCéim includes **Orfeo ed Euridice** for Blackwater Valley Opera Festival.



LEE CLAYDENPERFORMER

Lee is a shapeshifter who traverses the world of dance and aerial, finding his voice and flow in both. He trained at the London Contemporary Dance School, honing his skills within 4D at LCDS dancing pieces

by renowned choreographers like Wayne McGregor, Jonathon Lunn, Paul Taylor, Sue Davies and Mark Baldwin amongst others. His journey includes collaborations with prestigious companies such as Ricochet Dance Company and Richard Alston Dance Company. Notably, he appeared in Rafael Bonachela's awardwinning duet, **E2 7SD**, earning a Critics' Circle National Dance Award nomination. As an aerial dancer, Lee flies off cranes, walls, and any surface that can be transformed into art. Often seen with Gravity & Levity performing vertical dance pieces, Why? and **Crawdaddy**. With FidgetFeet for 13 years he has worked on The Snow Queen, Catch me, Hang on, Firebirds, A Fairies' Tail, The Elves and the Shoemaker and The Second Coming. On the ground for the last 10 years dancing with Company Chameleon in Beauty of the Beast, Of man and Beast, Hands down and the **Shadow**. Lee teaches, choreographs, mentors and devices on the floor and in the air regularly for various companies and dance establishments across the United Kingdom and Internationally. He is also a certified Gyrotonics and Vayu Aerial yoga instructor which he runs from his studio 360 Bodyworks in Manchester. He is delighted to be back once again with CoisCéim adding to Boxes, Faun, Body Language, In The Magic Hour repertoire.



JUSTINE COOPER PERFORMER & REHEARSAL DIRECTOR

Originally from New Zealand, Justine has been based in Ireland as a freelance dance artist, teacher and choreographer since 2008. She is a guest lecturer at The University of Limerick, Dance Ireland & Dance Theatre of

Ireland and this year graduated as an advanced teacher in Quan Yin Qi Gong. Work with CoisCéim includes The Piece With The Drums, Go To Blazes, In The Magic Hour, Body Language, These Rooms, **Invitation to a Journey** and **Agnes**. As a dance artist Justine has had the pleasure of working most recently with Croí Glan, Justine Doswell, Junk Ensemble, Jools Gilson, Liz Roche Company, Laura Murphy, Mary Wycherly, Oona Doherty, United Fall, Maria Nilsson Waller, Anu Productions & Dead Center among many others. As a Movement Director Justine has worked with Ann Cleare on MIDHE (large scale orchestra and choir work) at the National Concert Hall, Una Kavanagh, Corn Exchange's MISFITS, nominated for Best Movement Direction 2018 Irish Times Theatre Awards, and Noelle Brown Theatre Company. Justine was a member of Meryl Tankard Australian Dance Theatre from 1998–2000. Her own work Folds of the Crane was presented as part of Tiger Dublin Fringe Festival 2015 (nominated for Spirit of the Fringe & Best Lighting & Design) also presented at Dublin Dance Festival 2016 and What's Next Festival 2018.



MORGAN CROWLEYPERFORMER

Palimpsest marks Morgan's CoisCéim Debut. Dublin-born, he has had a diverse career across five continents, appearing on a Grammy-winning CD, Tony Award winning musical and the stage version of

an Oscar-winning film. Morgan trained classically in music and drama and is a Masters Graduate of Trinity College Dublin. He works extensively in all media with credits worldwide including BBC's **Eastenders**, Disney, The Wiggles, National Theatre/RSC, Royal Opera Covent Garden, Prometheus, Messiah, Universal Pictures & Columbia Artists. Notable Broadway/West-End/international theatre leading roles include **Phantom of the Opera, Hairspray, Chicago, Sweeney Todd, Cirque du Soleil, Riverdance, Scrooge** and **Playboy of the Western World**.



EILÍS DEXTER PERFORMER

Palimpsest marks Eilís's CoisCéim debut. She is a mezzo-soprano from Dublin whose work spans from choral music to opera and contemporary compositions. She studied Music at Trinity College

Dublin and Voice at the Royal Irish Academy of Music. Eilís is an established ensemble singer, performing regularly with groups such as Resurgam, Lassus, Tonnta and Ardú. As an oratorio soloist she has performed works by Handel, Bach, Pergolesi, d'Astorga, Saint-Saëns and Duruflé. Operatic engagements include Irish National Opera, Opera Collective Ireland and Blackwater Valley Opera Festival. Eilís was awarded 1st Place in the Mezzo-soprano Solo competition in the 2022 Feis Ceoil and was a member of the Glyndebourne Academy 2023. Eilís also has a strong dance background and looks to engage in multidisciplinary projects.



VANESSA GUEVARA PERFORMER

Palimpsest marks Vanessa's CoisCéim debut with the company. A Dancer-Choreographer specialising in contemporary and traditional Mexican and African diaspora dance. She was first introduced to movement

at a very young age by her parents who were both yoga teachers at the time. Her passion and curiosity for storytelling and community-related projects led her to perform Mexican traditional dances around the world, sharing her practice to professional dancers, children, senior citizens, young offenders and refugees. She started her professional training as a dancer at the National School of Contemporary Dance in Mexico and continued her training in the USA, Africa and Cuba. She has worked with Jose Agudo, Akram Khan (Opening Ceremony of London 2012 Olympic Games), Vocab Dance, State of Emergency, ACE Dance and Music, Voxed, National Company of Mexico, Heartbeat of Home (Riverdance) and Catherine Young Dance. Vanessa also worked with Gecko theatre company performing in their new show **KIN**, at the National Theatre, London, throughout January 2024.



SARAH LUTTRELL PERFORMER

Palimpsest marks Sarah's CoisCéim debut. A mezzosoprano, Sarah graduated from the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland Master's degree in performance in 2022. She was the recipient of the RCS Trust Postgraduate

Scholarship. To date, Sarah has been a soloist on the Operatic, Concert and Oratorio platform in Ireland, The United Kingdom and Europe. In 2021–2022, Sarah was a scholar with the 2023 Grammy-nominated British vocal group Voces8, a full time member of Chamber Choir Ireland 2022–2023 and a member of the Wexford Festival Opera Young Artist Programme 2022–2023. Future engagements include INO's **La Traviata**, Stanford's Mass in G Major, Dublin and the East Cork Choral Society's performance of Handel's **Samson**.



RENAKO MCDONALDPERFORMER

Palimpsest marks Renako's CoisCéim debut with the company. He is an award-winning dancer, who starred in the West End, toured globally, and worked on multiple films, TV series and commercials. His

credits include Cirque Du Soleil, Walt Disney Studios, Netflix, Marvel, Jason Derulo, Riverdance and Disney's Musical **Tarzan** to mention a few. Renako has been acknowledged by Madonna, and won her *Art for Freedom Campaign* for his starring role in multi award-winning short film **Shift**. He has also had the incredible honour of being personally invited to perform his choreography for The Queen of the United Kingdom and 400+ VIP guests at Buckingham Palace.



JONATHAN MITCHELL PERFORMER & REHEARSAL DIRECTOR

Jonathan graduated from the Rambert School, London, in 1992. Since then he has been fortunate to work with a host of choreographers and companies, including Adventures in Motion Pictures, Mathew

Hawkins, Liz Roche Company and IMDT, performing on four continents and in both hemispheres. Jonathan's association with CoisCéim began in 2001 with **The Rite of Spring**, and he has worked with the company many times since, including **When Once Is Never Enough, Mermaids, Pageant, Agnes, The Wolf and Peter, These Rooms, Body Language, In The Magic Hour, Francis Footwork, Orfeo ed Euridice for the Blackwater Valley Opera Festival, Go To Blazes** and **The Piece With The Drums**.



MÁIRE NÍ GHRÁINNE PERFORMER

Palimpsest marks Máire's CoisCéim debut. She was an Abbey Player from 1967–1999. She has appeared in over 150 productions at the Abbey Theatre. Among her favourites are **The Loves of Cass McGuire**, **The Cherry**

Orchard, Famine, The Playboy of the Western World, The Hostage (Best Supporting Actress Evening Herald), A State of Chassis, The Plebians Rehearse the Uprising, Innish, Uncle Vanya, Finders **Keepers** (Irish Times Theatre Award nomination for Best Supporting Actress), Ulysses in Nighttown and April Bright. Television work includes Going into Exile, The Country Boy, Glenroe, O'Flaherty VC, Ballykissangel, The Loves of Cass McGuire, Mother Courage, The Hanging Gale (BBC and RTÉ), **Z-cars** and **The Pallisers** (BBC) and **Ros na Rún** (TG4). Film work includes The Fighting Prince of Donegal, Ulysses, Here are Ladies, Ar Dover Féin. Máire recently appeared in the Long **Christmas Dinner** at the Peacock Theatre and was nominated for a Best Supporting Actress by The Irish Times, 2022.



ALEX O'NEILL PERFORMER

Alex's work with CoisCéim includes **The Piece With The Drums** and **Orfeo ed Euridice** for the Blackwater Valley Opera Festival. He has performed on RTÉ's **Supercrew** 2010–2011, **Mrs Browns Boys Da Movie**

2014, **Ek Tha Tiger** 2012 and **Vikings** 2018. He was a featured dancer in the Ireland's **Got Talent** Advert live shows 2019, Alex's work in film includes Ridley Scott's **The Last Duel** 2021, James Vincent McMorrow's **Gone** 2020 and Disney's **Disenchanted** 2022. He has worked on Red Bull, RTÉ, Apple, Heineken, Ryanair, Facebook, Google, Vodafone and Orchard Thieves and Lifestyle Sports Christmas Campaign/Adverts 2018 & 2021. He was head choreographer for the 80's & 90's Disco European Arena Tour (2018–2020). He has been a soloist in Monica Loughman's annual production of **The Nutcracker** 2012–2015 and Michael Jackson **Man in the Mirror Tribute** tour 2014–2016. Other theatre performances include **The Hardest of Women** Anu 2022. Recent work includes being cast as *The Watcher* in Dakota Fanning's upcoming film **The Watchers** 2023 and performing in **Mosh** winner of Best Ensemble at the Dublin Fringe Festival Awards 2023.



DONKING RONGAVILLAPERFORMER

Donking is originally from the Philippines, and has been based in Ireland since 2002. He started his professional dance career at 16 as a choreographer, acrobatic teacher, actor and dance fitness coach. His

dance credits for CoisCéim include **Agnes, Our Father** and **Orfeo ed Euridice** for Blackwater Valley Opera Festival. He has danced in RTÉ's Centenary 2016. Irish National Opera's production of Bizet's **Carmen** 2022 at the Bord Gais Energy Theatre. He also performed in RTÉ's **Toy Show the Musical** 2022. Television and film credits include **The Vikings, Love Hate, Raw, Aisling's Diary, Grand Opening** and commercials for The Orchard Thieves and EIR Sports. **Ballet Chancers** with Monica Loughman for RTÉ. Acting credits include Netflix's **nocebo** with Eva Green, 2023. **Love Rosie** with Lily Collins, 2015. **Herself** produced by Sharon Horgan, 2021. **West Side Story** at the Bordgas theatre 2021. Choreography credits include the award-winning Bollywood short film **Moore Street Masala** and RTÉ's **Tina Times Two** for Dyehouse Films. **Cinderella** 2021 and **Matilda Jr** 2022 for RNR musical society. And assistant choreographer for the annual Gaiety Pantos 2016—2021.



ROSIE STEBBINGPERFORMER

Rosie is a contemporary dance artist from Kildare. After studying at the Northern School of Contemporary Dance (UK) on their foundation course, she moved to the Netherlands to train at ArtEZ Institute of the

Arts, graduating with a BA(Hons) in Dance in 2021. During the final year of her studies she joined Holstebro Dansekompagni in Denmark as an apprentice dancer. She also participated in Dance Limerick's Step Up project, working with choreographers David Bolger and Lucyna Zwolinska on the creation and tour of two new works. Rosie made her CoisCéim debut in Go To Blazes. She has also performed with Fidget Feet Aerial Dance Theatre, Fíbín sa Taibhdhearc, Emily Aoibheann and Peter Power/ Sparsile Collective. Her choreographic debut **Test 1**, created and performed with Ornella Dufay-Miralles, premiered at the Dublin Fringe Festival in 2022 and was winner of the Judges' Choice Award. Rosie has been supported by the Arts Council of Ireland through the Dance Agility and Bursary Awards, and was the recipient of Dance Ireland's HATCH Mentorship Award 2023. This year she has been commissioned by Dublin Youth Dance Company to create a new work for the senior company.



MATEUSZ SZCZEREK PERFORMER

Mateusz is a Dublin based dancer/choreographer and creative director for Human Collective, his movement is based in street dance and contemporary, Krump and Breaking. He also curates one of the biggest

festivals for street dance in Ireland called **Dance2Connect**. Matt made his CoisCéim debut in **The Wolf and Peter**. He previously worked with choreographers Botis Seva, Jill Crovisier, Joseph Toonga, Monica Martin Munoz and many others.



JESSIE THOMPSON PERFORMER

Jessie is a Dublin based dance artist specialising in experimental contemporary and Hip Hop dance. In 2023 Jessie Thompson was the Inaugural artist commissioned by CoisCéim and Waterways Ireland

to create and perform a site specific solo titled **Bench**. Jessie also choreographed and performed in **This Solution** in Dublin Theatre Festival and presented a solo in progress **Crawler** at Dublin Dance Festival 2022 and 2023, Jessie is now a guest choreographer for Limerick Youth Dance Company 2024. She has performed in Maria Nilsson Waller's **Riverine**, Emma Martin/United Fall's **Night Dances** in Dublin Theatre Festival and Edinburgh Fringe, Rosie Stebbing's **Test 1** in WhatNext Festival and worked with companies such as TasteinYourMouth, OnetwoOneTwo, Monica Munoz, Liz Roche Company, Simone O'Toole. Jessie won Red Bull's **Dance Your Style Ireland** in 2023 and represented Ireland in the world Final.



ALEXANDRA VOSTOKOVAPERFORMER

Palimpsest marks Alexandra's CoisCéim debut. She is an Irish dancer, choreographer, teacher and director, working across live performance, improvisation and film. Alexandra began her education in contemporary

and theatre in Izhevsk, Russia, before coming to Ireland, where since 2015 she had been extensively involved with Dublin Youth Dance Company, which facilitated her growth and development in contemporary dance. She continued her training across several dance hubs in Europe, most prominently in Berlin engaging with contemporary, Hip Hop, acrobatics and physical theatre practices. Alex has performed in works by Liz Roche, John Scott, Simone O'Toole, Pan Pan Theatre, Dance2Connect and Stereo 48 dance company.



KATE ELLIS CELLIST

Cellist Kate Ellis is dedicated to the performance and exploration of all things new in music with collaboration at the heart. Her work with CoisCéim includes **Invitation** to a **Journey** and **Cello Counterpoint**. She is Artistic

Director of Crash Ensemble, cellist with Martin Hayes' Common Ground Ensemble and toured with Bono as part of his Stories of Surrender show 2022–2023. Kate has collaborated with, commissioned, premiered and recorded works by composers Steve Reich, Bryce Dessner, David Lang, Michael Gordon, Nico Muhly and Donnacha Dennehy and continues to push musical boundaries performing and recording with musicians including Bono and the Edge, Bobby McFerrin, Rhiannon Giddens, Martin Hayes, Gavin Friday, Ye Vagabonds, Lisa O'Neill and Glenn Hansard. Kate has toured and broadcast in Australia, USA, Europe and China, performing at Carnegie Hall, the Kennedy Centre, Shanghai EXPO, Istanbul Akbank Jazz Festival and Edinburgh International Festival with releases on Nonesuch, Cantaloupe, Rough Trade, Domino, Brawl Records, Bada Bing, Crash Records and Claddagh Records. Recent projects include the release of a major new work for solo cello by Northern Irish composer Ed Bennett on the Ergodos label, a duo collaboration with Martin Hayes, curation of a contemporary music series **Europe: Here and Now** at the National Concert Hall. Dublin and the creation of new music for the Multi-Traction Orchestra's album 'Reactor One' and Echolocation: Resonate from Here; a collaborative album with UK and US based musicians.

DAVID BOLGERDIRECTOR & CHOREOGRAPHER

David is the Artistic Director and co-founder of CoisCéim Dance Theatre. His work has been seen by millions of people worldwide and has received prestigious awards for its innovation, performance

and choreography.
